

- CT SCAN, ROUTINE ABDOMEN/PELVIS**
 No food 3 hours prior to exam. Drink 32 ounces of water 1 hour prior to exam. Bring 16 ounces of water to the appointment. If you are ONLY having a CT Scan and no other studies you do NOT have to hold your water and may use the restroom. If you are having multiple studies done please refer to prep for other studies.
- CT SCAN WITH CONTRAST & CTA STUDIES**
 Nothing to eat or drink 3 hours before exam. Drink plenty of fluids the day before the exam. Patients with diabetes, history of kidney disease or over the age of 65, a creatinine level within the past 6 weeks is needed.
- CTA CORONARY**
 Nothing to eat or drink 3 hours before exam. No caffeine after 6pm day before exam. If taking prescription blood pressure medicine, take in the morning.
- CT UROGRAM**
 Nothing to eat or drink 3 hours before exam. Bring 24oz of water to appointment. Upon arrival, drink all water and do not empty your bladder until the exam is completed. A full bladder is necessary for this exam.
- COLON STUDIES (BE)**
 Patient should pick up prep kit from pharmacy 2 days prior to the exam. Liquid diet 24 hours prior to the exam. Nothing to eat or drink after midnight or day of exam.
- DEXASCAN**
 No calcium tablets or vitamins 24 hours prior to exam. No zippers, snaps or metal on clothing.
- MAMMOGRAPHY**
 No powder, perfumes or deodorants on underarms or breast areas. PLEASE BRING ALL PREVIOUS MAMMOGRAM IMAGES, IF DONE ELSEWHERE, CD is preferable.
- MRI**
 If you have any type of surgical device/metal, please inform scheduler before scheduling exam. Please check manufacturer guidelines for MRI compatibility if you have not had it checked before. Also please bring in any type of documentation such as make/model of device on day of exam. Remove all metal jewelry before exam. You will be asked to change into a gown, if you are unable to change do not wear any clothing made from copper or silver infused material (ie: moisture/sweat wicking).
- MRI WITH CONTRAST**
 Hydrate with water before exam.
- MRI, ABDOMEN AND PELVIS**
 Nothing to eat 3 hours before the exam, water is ok.
- MRI, HEAD/BRAIN**
 No make-up, hair spray or mousse on day of exam.
- NUCLEAR MEDICINE**
 Please call, 702.515.8425, 24 hours prior to exam to confirm dose and receive prep instructions. Dosage is ordered based on patient specific criteria, if you do not confirm 24 hours prior to exam your wait time may increase.
- PET/CT**
 Nothing to eat or drink 4 hours before the exam, water and medications are ok. No exercise 24 hours prior to exam.
- UPPER GI SERIES (ESOPHAGRAM/SMALL BOWEL)**
 Nothing to eat or drink after midnight or day of exam.
- ULTRASOUND, ABDOMINAL**
 Nothing to eat or drink after midnight. NO FOOD OR DRNK until after the exam is completed.
- ULTRASOUND, PELVIC/OBSTETRIC**
 Eat a light meal. You must drink 48 ounces of water by the time you arrive for your exam. Begin drinking water 1 1/2 hours before your appointment time. Once water is consumed, do not empty bladder.
- ULTRASOUND, RENAL**
 Eat a light meal. You must drink 30 ounces of water by the time you arrive for your exam. Begin drinking water 1 1/2 hours before your appointment time. Once water is consumed, do not empty bladder.
- SPECIAL PROCEDURES**
 Contact Special Procedures department at 702.732.6020 for questions. NO blood thinners or aspirin products 5 days prior to any procedure. Additional prep unique to each exam will be given at the time of scheduling.

- Please do not bring unattended children under the age of 8.
- Please remember to leave your jewelry at home as it may interfere with the exam process and quality of the imaging.
- Female Patients: Depending on your exam you may be required to sign stating you are not pregnant and do not suspect pregnancy. If you do suspect there is a possibility of pregnancy or your last menstrual period was more than 4 weeks prior to your exam you can not be scanned without negative pregnancy blood test results, please bring these results with you.
